PRESS RELEASE

On August 29, 2016 at 1:37 pm, the DeKalb Police Department responded to report of a stabbing victim at 1025 Crane Drive. The incident started as a domestic dispute escalating to the offender attacking the victim with a knife causing multiple stab wounds. Officers arrived on scene and located the victim. The victim sustained multiple stab wounds to his legs and hands.

Officers located the offender, Crystal Boyd, Female, 22 years of age, DeKalb, and placed her under arrest following an investigation.

The victim was transported to Kishwaukee Hospital by DeKalb Fire Department and is being treated for non-life threatening injuries.

Boyd was charged with Aggravated Domestic Battery, a Class 2 Felony; Aggravated Battery, a Class 3 Felony; and two counts of Domestic Battery, a Class A Misdemeanor. Boyd was transported to the DeKalb County Jail to await a bond hearing.
