DeKalb Police seek offender for Aggravated Domestic Battery

The DeKalb Police Department is requesting assistance from the community to locate an offender wanted for Aggravated Domestic Battery and Aggravated Battery. On Wednesday, July 18th at approximately 3:07 am, the DeKalb Police Department responded to the 800 block of Russell Road for a reported domestic disturbance. During the investigation, officers learned that the offender, Deonte Travis, allegedly struck the victim with a weapon. Travis fled the scene prior to officers arrival and has not been located. The victim sustained serious injuries and was transported to Kishwaukee Hospital for treatment.

The DeKalb Police Department reviewed the investigation with the DeKalb County State's Attorney's Office. The following charges were approved against Travis: Aggravated Domestic Battery, Aggravated Battery, Unlawful Restraint, and Domestic Battery. A No Bond arrest warrant was issued today for Travis.
