

RESOLUTION 2019-138

PASSED: SEPTEMBER 23, 2019

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FY2019 MOTOR FUEL TAX FUNDS TO INITIATE ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE COMPLETION OF A CORRIDOR STUDY FOR PEACE ROAD BETWEEN ILLINOIS ROUTE 38 AND GURLER ROAD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$110,000.

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb, DeKalb County, Illinois ("the City") is a home rule community with those powers granted under the provisions of the Illinois Constitution and the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1.*et/seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb may allocate Motor Fuel Tax funds for Engineering Services related to roadway improvements; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is advisable, for staff to utilize outside vendors to perform a corridor study to aid in the responsible development of Peace Road from IL-38 to Gurler Road; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the City of DeKalb, Illinois, be authorized and directed to expend Motor Tax Fuel funds for completion of a corridor study for Peace Road between IL-38 and Gurler Road, at a cost not to exceed \$110,000 for FY2019.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk is hereby directed to transmit four (4) certified originals of this resolution to the district office of the Department of Transportation.

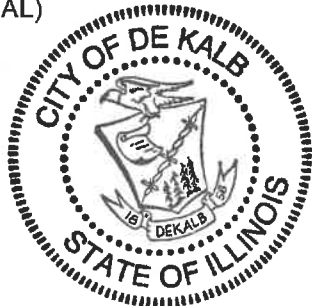
