BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the DeKalb of DeKalb Governing Body Type Local Public Agency Type Name of Local Public Agency Illinois that there is hereby appropriated the sum of Two Hundred Sixty Thousand, Six Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars and Fifteen Cents Dollars (\$206,623.15) of Motor Fuel Tax funds for the purpose of maintaining streets and highways under the applicable provisions of Illinois Highway Code from 01/01/19 to 12/31/19 Beginning Date Ending Date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that only those operations as listed and described on the approved Estimate of Maintenance Costs, including supplemental or revised estimates approved in connection with this resolution, are eligible for maintenance with Motor Fuel Tax funds during the period as specified above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that City of DeKalb Local Public Agency Type Name of Local Public Agency

shall submit within three months after the end of the maintenance period as stated above, to the Department of Transportation, on forms available from the Department, a certified statement showing expenditures and the balances remaining in the funds authorized for expenditure by the Department under this appropriation, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Assistant Clerk is hereby directed to transmit four (4) certified originals of this resolution to the district office of the Department of Transportation.



Dear Ms. Scott:

The supplemental resolution adopted by the City Council of DeKalb on December 9, 2019 appropriating \$206,623.15 of Motor Fuel Tax funds for the maintenance of streets and highways in the city from January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019 was approved on December 17, 2019.

With the additional funds appropriated above, a total of \$1,296,623.15 of Motor Fuel Tax funds has been appropriated for this improvement.

The revised Municipal Estimate of Maintenance Costs for \$1,231,623.15 was approved on December 17, 2019. This maintenance program is approved with the understanding that any claims for labor and equipment for day labor and routine maintenance will be on file and available for compliance review by Local Roads and Streets and for audit by the Bureau of Investigations and Compliance.

Authorization to expend an additional \$206,623.15 of Motor Fuel Tax funds for maintenance for this section has been approved and should appear on the city's next Motor Fuel Tax transaction detail.
