


PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Public Safety Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and

WHEREAS, Public Safety Telecommunicators are the single vital link for our police officers and firefighters by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information and ensuring their safety; and

WHEREAS, Public Safety Telecommunicators of the City of DeKalb have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and

WHEREAS, each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year;

THEREFORE, I, Jerry Smith, Mayor of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, do hereby declare local recognition and celebration of National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week from April 12 through 18, 2020 in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our city and citizens safe.
