AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR-END DECEMBER 31, 2020 BUDGET (MOTOR FUEL TAX FUND 210) OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the "City") is a home rule unit pursuant to Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City's corporate authorities find it in the City's best interests to amend the City's approved budget for Fiscal Year 2020 due to the receipt of capital monies from State sources to help finance a number of infrastructure improvements associated with the extraordinary Ferrara and Facebook developments along Gurler Road;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of DeKalb, DeKalb County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That, the City of DeKalb, which utilizes the Budget Process as contemplated by Article 8, Division 2 of the Illinois Municipal Code including, but not limited to 65 ILCS 5/8-2-9.1 through 65 ILCS 5/8-2-9.10, adopts an amendment to its FY2019 Budget, as shown below:

That each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 3. Upon its passage and approval according to law, this Ordinance shall by authority of the City Council be published in pamphlet form.
