APPROVING A CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS REFERENDUM ON THE APRIL 6, 2021 CONSOLIDATED ELECTION BALLOT WITH REGARD TO URBAN CHICKENS WITHIN THE DEKALB, ILLINOIS CORPORATE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the "City") finds that it is in the best interests of the City and its citizens to provide for an advisory referendum to be submitted to its voters concerning whether the City should permit the keeping of backyard chickens if the inspection, licensing and registration requirements can be performed on a cost-neutral basis to the City; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of DeKalb, DeKalb County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The recitals to this Resolution are true, material, adopted, and incorporated herein as Section 1 to this Resolution.

**SECTION 2:** An advisory public question on whether the City should permit the keeping of backyard chickens if the inspection, licensing and registration requirements can be performed on a cost-neutral basis to the City shall be submitted to the voters of the City in accordance with the general election law at the consolidated election to be held on Tuesday, April 6, 2021 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on said day (the "Election").

**SECTION 3:** The Election shall be held in the voting precincts and at the polling places established by the County Board (the "County Board") of the County of DeKalb, Illinois (the "County"), for the voters of the City at said consolidated election.

**SECTION 4:** The County Clerk of DeKalb County (the "County Clerk") shall give notice of the Election in accordance with the general election law, including the translations thereof as deemed by the County Clerk to be required by law (the "Notice") by: (i) publishing notice thereof once not more than sixty (60) nor less than ten (10) days prior to the date for the Election in a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the City; and (ii) posting a copy of the Notice at least ten (10) days before the date of the Election at the principal office of the County Clerk.

**SECTION 5:** It is hereby found and determined that the Daily Chronicle is a local, community newspaper of general circulation in the City, and suitable for publication of the Notice pursuant to the requirements of Section 12-5 of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended (the "Election Code").

**SECTION 6:** The City Clerk or Executive Assistant shall post a copy of the Notice at the principal office of the City.

**SECTION 7:** The Notice shall appear over the name or title of the County Clerk and shall be in substantially the following form:

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that at the general primary election to be held on Tuesday, April 6, 2021, the following proposition will be submitted to the voters of the City of DeKalb, DeKalb County, Illinois:

**SECTION 11:** The Election shall be held and conducted and the returns thereof duly canvassed, all in a manner and time provided by the general election law.

**SECTION 12:** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

**SECTION 13:** That the City Clerk and/or the Executive Assistant of the City of DeKalb, Illinois be authorized and directed to attest the Mayor's signature and that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
