RESOLUTION 2020-099

AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES, INC. (C.E.S.) FOR THE ENGINEERING DESIGN OF AFTON ROAD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$95,000.

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb, DeKalb County, Illinois ("the City") is a home rule community with those powers granted under the provisions of the Illinois Constitution and the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb has applied for and desires to utilize State and Federal funding and must meet the planning requirements for that funding; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is advisable for staff to utilize outside vendors to perform engineering design services in the development of Afton Road from Gurler Road to Keslinger Road; and

WHEREAS, the City maintains relationships for services with several firms, among which are Civil Engineering Services, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, be authorized and directed to enter into a Professional Service Agreement with Civil Engineering Services, Inc. for Engineering Design of Afton Road in an amount not to exceed \$95,000 in a form acceptable to him.

SECTION 2: That the City Clerk and/or the Executive Assistant of the City of DeKalb, Illinois be authorized and directed to attest the Mayor's signature and shall be effective thereupon.

That any difference between the ENGINEER and the LA concerning the interpretation of the provisions of this AGREEMENT shall be referred to a committee of disinterested parties consisting of one member appointed by the

ENGINEER one member appointed by the LA and a third member appointed by the two other members for disposition and that the committee's decision shall be final.

For breach or violation of this warranty the LA shall have the right to annul this contract without liability.

Upon such termination, the ENGINEER shall cause to be delivered to the LA all drawings, specifications, partial and completed estimates and data if any from traffic studies and soil survey and subsurface investigations with the understanding that all such material becomes the property of the LA. The ENGINEER shall be paid for any services completed and any services partially completed in accordance with Section 4 of THE LA AGREES.
- 3. That if the contract for construction has not been awarded one year after the acceptance of the plans by the LA and their approval by the DEPARTMENT, the LA will pay the ENGINEER the balance of the engineering fee due to make 100 percent of the total fees due under the AGREEMENT, based on the estimate of cost as prepared by the ENGINEER and approved by the LA and the DEPARTMENT.
- 4. That the ENGINEER warrants that he/she has not employed or retained any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for the ENGINEER, to solicit or secure this contract and that he/she has not paid or agreed to pay any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for the ENGINEER, any fee, commission, percentage, brokerage fee, gifts or any other consideration contingent upon or resulting from the award or making of this contract. For breach or violation of this warranty the LA shall have the right to annul this contract without liability.
