

AMENDING CHAPTER 51 "TRAFFIC", SCHEDULE C "PARKING PROHIBITED" AND SCHEDULE I "SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES" OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL CODE AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTABLISHING SNOW ROUTE DESIGNATION AND SCHOOL ZONE SET-BACK ON BARB BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the "City") is a home rule unit of local government which may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 51 of the City's Municipal Code (the "Code") regulates traffic within the City's corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the City's corporate authorities find that is in the City's best interests to amend Chapter 51 of the Code in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance to promote the public health, safety, welfare and morals; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: The City's corporate authorities hereby amend Chapter 51, "Traffic", Schedule C, "Parking Prohibited", of the Code as follows (additions are indicated by double underlining and deletions are indicated by double ~~strike through~~ markings):

1. No Parking at Any Time

* * *

Barb Boulevard, north side, from the west right of way line of South Fourth Street to a point ~~385~~ 410 feet west.

19. No Parking at Any Time – December 1 to April 1

* * *

~~Barb Boulevard, south side, from the west entrance of the DeKalb High School parking lot to South First Street.~~

21. No Parking 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Regular School Days.

Barb Boulevard, north side, from a point ~~385~~ 410 feet west of the west right of way line of South Fourth Street to the east right of way line of South Second Street.

SECTION 2: The City's corporate authorities hereby amend Chapter 51, "Traffic", Schedule I, "Snow Emergency Routes", of the Code as follows (additions are indicated by double underlining and deletions are indicated by double ~~strike through~~ markings):

SECTION 3: Except as may otherwise be amended by this ordinance, Chapter 51 of the Code shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: This ordinance and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such ordinance should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the City's corporate authorities that to the extent that the terms of this ordinance should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, that this ordinance shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction. The invalidity of any section of this ordinance shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval as provided by law.
