

RESOLUTION 2022-025

PASSED: MARCH 14, 2022

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A WORKERS' COMPENSATION LUMP SUM PETITION AND ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,559.25 (JEFFREY WINTERS).

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the "City") is a home rule unit of local government and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, City staff negotiated a lump sum settlement in the amount of \$20,559.25 for Jeffrey Winters's workers' compensation claim against the City (the "Settlement"); and

WHEREAS, the City's corporate authorities find that the Settlement is in the City's best interests for the promotion of the public health, morals and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: The City's corporate authorities approve, authorize, and direct the City Manager or his designee to execute a lump sum petition and order for the Settlement of a pending Workers' Compensation Claim with Jeffrey Winters, contemplating the payment of all outstanding medical bills associated with his compensable injury, and also contemplating the payment of a permanent partial disability lump sum payment in the amount of Twenty Thousand Five Hundred and Fifty-Nine Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$20,559.25), subject to approval by the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission (IWCC), and to take all necessary actions to effect the Settlement.

SECTION 2: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, at a Regular meeting thereof held on the 14th day of March 2022 and approved by me as Mayor on the same day.
