APPROVING THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC FOR THE PURPOSE OF HOLDING THE ANNUAL DEKALB CORN FEST ON ILLINOIS ROUTE 38 (LINCOLN HIGHWAY) BETWEEN FIRST STREET AND FOURTH STREET BEGINNING THURSDAY, AUGUST 25, 2022, AT 4:00 P.M., THROUGH SUNDAY, AUGUST 28, 2022, AT 10:00 P.M.

**PASSED: JUNE 27, 2022** 

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the "City") is a home rule unit of local government and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

**WHEREAS**, the annual Corn Fest (the "Event") in the City, which is a public recreational festival held in part on City property; and

WHEREAS, the Event requires the temporary closure of Illinois Route 38 (Lincoln Highway), a State Highway in the City, in the area between First Street and Fourth Street, during the hours of 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 25, 2022, until 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.408 of the Illinois Highway Code authorizes the Illinois Department of Transportation ("IDOT") to issue permits to local authorities to temporarily close portions of State Highways for public purposes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS, that the City requests permission from IDOT to close off Illinois Route 38 (Lincoln Highway), in the area between First Street and Fourth Street, during the hours of 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 25, 2022, until 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 28, 2022 (the "Closure").

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Closure shall occur during the approximate time period of 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 25, 2022, until 10:00 p.m. Sunday, August 28, 2022.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that traffic from the Closure shall be detoured over routes with an all-weather surface that can accept the anticipated traffic, maintained to the satisfaction of IDOT, and conspicuously marked for the benefit of traffic diverted from the Closure (the "Detour Route").

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Detour Route from the Closure shall be as follows:

**Westbound Traffic:** Beginning at the intersection of Route 38 (Lincoln Highway) and Route 23 (Fourth Street) turn north to the Sycamore Road extension at Clinton Rosette School; turn left (southwest) on the Sycamore Road extension past said school; turn left (south) on North First Street to Lincoln Highway; turn right (west) on Route 38 (Lincoln Highway).

**Eastbound Traffic:** Beginning at Route 38 (Lincoln Highway), turn left (north) on North First Street; turn right (northeast) on Sycamore Road extension; turn right (south) on Route 23 (Fourth Street) to the intersection of Route 38 (Lincoln Highway) and Route 23 (Fourth Street); turn left (east) on Route 38 (Lincoln Highway).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City shall assume full responsibility for the traffic control police protection services for the Detour Route, subject to the immunities and defenses provided by law.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that police officers or authorized flaggers shall, at the City's expense, be positioned at each end of the Closure and at such other locations to provide traffic control police protection services for the Detour Route.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that police officers, flaggers, and officials shall permit emergency vehicles in emergency situations to pass through the Closure.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City shall remove debris from the Closure prior to reopening the State Highway.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that such signs, flags, barricades, and other traffic control measures shall be provided and used by the City as may be approved by IDOT.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Closure and Detour Route shall be marked according to the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that to the fullest extent permitted by law, the City shall indemnify and hold harmless IDOT, its officers, employees, and agents from any and all claims, lawsuits, actions, costs and fees (including reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses) of every nature or description, arising out of, resulting from or connected with the exercise of authority granted by IDOT that is the subject of this Resolution. The obligation is binding upon the City, regardless of whether or not such claim, damage, loss or expense is caused in part by the act, omission or negligence of the IDOT or its officers, employees or agents. Notwithstanding the foregoing to the contrary, the City shall be entitled to the immunities and defenses provided by law including, but not limited to, 745 ILCS 10/1, et seq.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City shall provide a comprehensive general liability policy or an additional named insured endorsement in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000 per person and \$2,000,000 aggregate, which names IDOT and its officials, employees and agents as additional insureds, a copy of which shall be provided to IDOT upon its request.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to IDOT to serve as a formal request for the permission sought in this Resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such resolution should (a) contain terms contrary to the provision of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the City's corporate authorities that to the extent that the terms of this resolution should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, that this resolution shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of DeKalb, Illinois at a Regular meeting thereof held on the 27th day of June 2022 and approved by me as Mayor on the same day. Passed by


