

**AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO ALLIANCE CONTRACTORS, INC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$53,512.50 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALK EXTENSION ALONG ANNIE GLIDDEN ROAD WITH STAFF AUTHORITY TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS UP TO A COMBINED PROJECT TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of DeKalb (the "City") is a home rule unit of local government and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 16, 2022, the City publicly opened bids for the Annie Glidden Sidewalk Extension consisting of installing concrete sidewalk to connect existing termini at Twombly Road and Dresser Road (the "Project") with the lowest responsible bidder being Alliance Contractors, Inc (the "Contractor") in the total amount of \$53,512.50 (the "Bid"); and

**WHEREAS**, the City's corporate authorities find that approving the Contractor's Bid is in the City's best interests for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:**

**SECTION 1:** The recitals to this resolution are adopted and incorporated herein as Section One to this Resolution.

**SECTION 2:** The City's corporate authorities approve, authorize, and direct the City Manager to enter into an agreement, in a form acceptable to him, with Contractor for the Project for the Bid amount of \$53,512.50 with staff authority to approve change orders up to a combined Project total of \$60,000.

**SECTION 3:** This resolution and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such resolution should (a) contain terms contrary to the provision of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the City's corporate authorities that to the extent that the terms of this resolution should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, this resolution shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

**SECTION 4:** This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

1. **Debt Delinquency.** The bidder or contractor or subcontractor, respectively, certifies that it is not delinquent in the payment of any tax administered by the Department of Revenue unless the individual or other entity is contesting, in accordance with the procedure established by the appropriate Revenue Act, its liability for the tax or the amount of the tax. Making a false statement voids the contract and allows the Department to recover all amounts paid to the individual or entity under the contract in a civil action.

2. **Bid-Rigging or Bid Rotating.** The bidder or contractor or subcontractor, respectively, certifies that it is not barred from contracting with the Department by reason of a violation of either 720 ILCS 5/33E-3 or 720 ILCS 5/33E-4.

A violation of section 33E-3 would be represented by a conviction of the crime of bid-rigging which, in addition to Class 3 felony sentencing, provides that any person convicted of this offense, or any similar offense of any state or the United States which contains the same elements as this offense shall be barred for 5 years from the date of conviction from contracting with any unit of State or local government. No corporation shall be barred from contracting with any unit of State or local government as a result of a conviction under this Section of any employee or agent of such corporation if the employee so convicted is no longer employed by the corporation: (1) It has been finally adjudicated not guilty or (2) If it demonstrates to the governmental entity with which it seeks to contract that entity finds that the commission of the offense was neither authorized, requested, commanded, nor performed by a director, officer or a high managerial agent on behalf of the corporation.

A violation of Section 33E-4 would be represented by a conviction of the crime of bid-rotating which, in addition to Class 2 felony sentencing, provides that any person convicted of this offense or any similar offense of any state or the United States which contains the same elements as this offense shall be permanently barred from contracting with any unit of State or Local government. No corporation shall be barred from contracting with any unit of State or Local government as a result of a conviction under this Section of any employee or agent of such corporation if the employee so convicted is no longer employed by the corporation and: (1) it has been finally adjudicated not guilty or (2) If it demonstrates to the governmental entity with which it seeks to contract and that entity finds that the commission of the offense was neither authorized, requested, commanded, nor performed by a director, officer or a high managerial agent on behalf of the corporation.

3. **Bribery.** The bidder or contractor or subcontractor, respectively, certifies that, it has not been convicted of bribery or attempting to bribe an officer or employee of the State of Illinois or any unit of local government, nor has the firm made an admission of guilt of such conduct which is a matter of record, nor has an official, agent, or employee of the firm committed bribery or attempted bribery on behalf of the firm and pursuant to the direction or authorization of a responsible official of the firm.
4. **Interim Suspension or Suspension.** The bidder or contractor or subcontractor, respectively, certifies that it is not currently under a suspension as defined in Subpart 1 of Title 44 Subtitle A Chapter III Part 6 of the Illinois Administrative code. Furthermore, if suspended prior to completion of this work, the contract or contracts executed for the completion of this work may be canceled.

## SUPPLEMENTAL SPECIFICATIONS

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The following Special Provisions supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", Adopted January 1, 2022, the latest edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways", and the "Manual of Test Procedures of Materials" in effect on the date of invitation of bids, and the Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions indicated on the Check Sheet included here in which apply to and govern the construction and in case of conflict with any part, or parts, of said Specifications, the said Special Provisions shall take precedence and shall govern.

For this section ENGINEER refers to current City Engineer of DeKalb.

### **LOCATION OF PROJECT**

The project is located along the west side of Annie Glidden Road between the intersections of Twombly Road and Dresser Road in DeKalb, Illinois.

### **DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT**

The project consists of installing new concrete sidewalk, including earth excavation, aggregate base coarse, and other related standard appurtenances.

### **PROSECUTION OF THE WORK**

The contractor shall give the City of DeKalb written notice one (1) week prior to the start of construction. Annie Glidden Road must remain open to thru traffic for the duration of the project. All traffic control devices must be in place and approved by the County prior to beginning construction. All improvements must be completed by **November 4, 2022**. Failure to complete the project within the specified time will result in assessment of liquidated damages in accordance with the Standard Specifications.

### **PRECAUTIONS FOR UTILITIES**

The Contractor shall take whatever precautions which may be necessary to protect the property of the various public utilities which may be located underground or above ground, at or adjacent to the site of this improvement. Needed adjustments of these facilities will be made by the respective utility companies if so required. These facilities shall be saved harmless, and care shall be exercised so as not to disrupt or destroy the services provided by these utilities. ## **TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN**

Effective: January 14, 1999

Revised: July 22, 2015

Traffic control shall be according to the applicable section of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, the applicable guidelines contained in the National Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, Illinois Supplement to the National Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, these special provisions, and any special details and Highway Standards contained herein and in the plans.

Special attention is called to Articles 107.09 and 107.14 of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction and the following Highway Standards relating to traffic control.

### **Standards:**

### **General:**

- 1) The contractor is required to conduct routine inspections of the work site at a frequency that will allow for the prompt replacement of any traffic control device that has become worn or damaged to the extent that it no longer conforms to the shape, dimensions, color and operational requirements of the MUTCD, and the traffic control standards, or will no longer present a clear appearance to motorists. A sufficient quantity of replacement devices, based on vulnerability to damage, shall be readily available to meet this requirement. If, in the opinion of the engineer, the traffic control devices are not acceptable in appearance they shall be repaired or replaced, upon notice from the engineer, to his satisfaction within 24 hours.
- 2) Each Type III Barricade shall have two (2) Type A, Low Intensity lights mounted on top.

**Signs:** No bracing shall be allowed on post-mounted signs. Post-mounted signs shall be installed using standard 720011, 728001, 729001, on 4" x 4" wood posts, or on any other "break away" connection if accepted by the FHWA and corresponding letter is provided to the resident.

All signs are required on both sides of the road when the median is greater than 10 feet and on one-way roadways.

The "WORKERS" (W21-1a(O)-48) signs shall be replaced with symbol "Right or Left Lane Closed Ahead" (W4-2R or L(O)-48) signs on multilane roadways.

"BUMP" (W8-1(O)48) signs shall be installed as directed by the Engineer.

When covering existing Department signs, no tape shall be used on the reflective portion of the sign. Contact the District sign shop for covering techniques.

All regulatory signs shall be maintained at a 5-foot minimum bottom (rural), 7 foot minimum (urban).

Plate altering signs shall have the same sheeting as the base sign.

No more than one plate shall be used to alter a sign.

Any post stubs with a sign in place and visible shall have a reflector placed on each post.

#### Devices:

Cones or reflectorized cones shall not be used during hours of darkness.

A minimum of 3 drums spaced at 4 feet shall be placed at each return when the sideroad is open.

On all standards, and the devices listed in Section 701 of the Standard Specifications, the device spacing shall be revised to the following dimensions:

Where the spacing shown on the standard is 25 feet, the devices shall be placed at 20 feet.

Where the spacing shown on the standard is 50 feet, the devices shall be placed at 40 feet.

Where the spacing shown on the standard is 100 feet, the devices shall be placed at 80 feet.

Direction Indicator Barricades shall exclusively be used in lane closure tapers. The backside of the direction indicator barricades shall be striped like a type II barricade when opposing traffic is within 12 feet of the device. The taper shall be continuous. It shall not be broken for access to turn lanes, side roads, ramps, or large commercial driveways. The taper shall be moved further away and shall be completed prior to the access point.

#### Lights:

Steady burn mono-directional lights are required on devices delineating a widening trench.

#### Flagger at Sideroads and Commercial Entrances:

Effective: August 1, 2011

Revised: July 22, 2015

Flaggers shall comply with all requirements contained in the Department's "Flagger Handbook" dated September 2011. The flagger equipment listed for flaggers employed by the Illinois Department of Transportation shall apply to all flaggers.

All works and flaggers shall wear ANSI Class E pants and an ANSI Class 2 vest that in combination meet the requirements of ANSI/ISEA 107-2004 for Conspicuity Class 3 garments during hours of darkness.

When the road is closed to through traffic and it is necessary to provide access for local traffic, all flaggers shown on the applicable standards will be required. No reduction in the number of flaggers shall be allowed.

Revised the first and second paragraph of Article 701.20(i) of the Standard Specifications to read:

"Signs, barricades, other traffic control devices, or flaggers required by the Engineer, over and above those shown in the contract documents, will be paid for according to Article 109.04".

All traffic control shall be in place as approved by the City prior to beginning work.

The cost of all traffic control required by these Special Provisions and the Standards and Specifications will be considered incidental to the item PCC SIDEWALK 6 INCH.

### **EARTH EXCAVATION (SPECIAL)**

This work shall consist of excavation for the sidewalk base coarse and proper positive drainage throughout the project in accordance with Section 202 of the Standard Specifications, these provisions, and as noted on the plans. This includes Top-soil Stripping.

This work shall be considered incidental to the item PCC SIDEWALK 6 INCH.

### **RESTORATION**

This work shall be done in accordance with the applicable portions of Section 250 and 251 of the Standard Specifications and as specified herein at locations shown on the plans. This work shall include the restoration of all disturbed areas as noted below.

Class 1A seed shall be applied to all disturbed areas as specified in Section 250 of the Standard Specifications.

Excelsior erosion control blanket shall be applied over all seeded areas meeting the requirements of Section 251. All fertilizing, seeding and erosion control blanket shall not be paid for separately but considered incidental to the item PCC SIDEWALK 6 INCH.

## **DETECTABLE WARNINGS**

All detectable warning plates shall be 10 Gauge Galvanized Steel in FED 22144 brick red. OWNER shall approve the material prior to order/delivery/installation or payment shall not be received.

This work shall be paid for by the Square Foot as DETECTABLE WARNINGS.

## **MODIFY CURB-HEAD**

This work shall consist of cutting and removing the existing curb-head to create a depressed curb for sidewalk ramp access of a forthcoming crosswalk. The width is anticipated to be 6.5 feet to accommodate a ramp width of slightly over 5 feet and 6-inch-wide pinned A type side-curb on both ramp edges. Adjacent pavement may not be disturbed as part of the efforts. Location/layout of the cut SHALL be approved in writing by the Engineer prior to execution or payment shall not be received.

Work shall be paid for by Each as MODIFY CURB-HEAD.

## **PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE SIDEWALK 6"**

This work shall be in accordance with all current Standards and Specification for Road and Bridge Construction. Execution/inspection of the work shall be as follows:

Location/layout exhibit is approximate; Engineer shall approve in writing the edges of the proposed sidewalk as marked in the field or payment shall not be received.

All Sidewalk Panel widths, unless otherwise approved by the Engineer in writing, shall be 5 feet.

All sidewalk panels and ramps shall be fully ADA compliant, or they will be removed and replaced at Contractor expense before ANY of the item quantity receives payment. It shall not be the Engineer's responsibility to ensure ADA compliance prior to or during PCC pour, regardless of layout/form approval.

Engineer shall approve in writing the Aggregate Base Coarse and final Forming prior to pour or no payment shall be received.

Cold joints shall be pinned as approved by Engineer.

Positive drainage from panels shall be executed; positive drainage between the existing curb and new sidewalk shall be ensured. 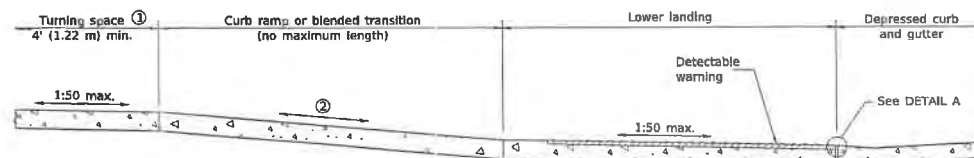




**RAMP IN LANDSCAPED AREA

When fluorescent signs are used, orange flags are not required.

Longitudinal dimensions may be adjusted to fit field conditions.

When the distance between the barricade and the intersection is between 1500' (450 m) and 2000' (600 m), the advance sign shall be placed at the intersection. When the distance between the barricade and the intersection is over 2000' (600 m), an additional sign shall be placed at the intersection. The additional sign shall give the distance to the barricade in miles or fractions of a mile.
