

**AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS CHAPTER 6, "STREETS, ALLEYS AND SIDEWALKS," SECTION 6.15, "RUBBISH IN STREETS," BY ADDING "SNOW."**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL** of the City of DeKalb, Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois Chapter 6, "Streets, Alleys and Sidewalks," Section 6.15, "Rubbish in Streets," be amended by inserting in the appropriate place the following:

No person shall throw, cast or put into or drop or leave in or on any street, alley, sidewalk, public place or any public grounds in the City any *snow*, dirt, stones, missiles, nails, ice, glass, ashes, iron, or any other metal, rubbish or any other article or thing.


**Section 2.** That each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

**Section 3.** That except as to the amendments heretofore mentioned, all Sections of the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 4.** Upon its passage and approval according to law, this Ordinance shall, by authority of the City Council be published in pamphlet form. On the tenth day after the date of publication, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect. Publication date: October 23, 2012. Effective date: November 1, 2012.
