

ORDINANCE 12-28 Passed: April 23, 2012

**FIXING THE SALARY AND COMPENSATION
OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF DEKALB,
ILLINOIS FOR AND DURING THE TERM OF
OFFICE COMMENCING MAY 2013, AND
THEREAFTER.**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 08-48 provided for salary and compensation of the Mayor as follows:

That the Mayor of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, shall receive the sum of \$22,500.00 per annum, payable in equal biweekly installments. The Mayor may elect to receive the same insurance benefits provided to City employees covered by Chapter 3, "City Administration," of the DeKalb Municipal Code. A Mayor who elects to be covered by the City's hospital and medical plan on either a single, single plus one (1) dependent or single plus multi-dependent (family) basis, shall pay the following premium during their term of office toward the cost of such coverage.

Commencing on January 1st of each year, said premium shall be increased by 10% and rounded to the nearest whole dollar amount. Medical, hospitalization, dental and life insurance benefits are as set forth in approved plan handbooks and are subject to change by action of the City Council.

WHEREAS, Section 2.15, "Elected Officials Salary Review" of Chapter 2, "City Council," of the Municipal Code states that the salary for City Council members shall be reviewed at the last regularly scheduled meeting in June preceding a general municipal election; and,

WHEREAS, the compensation of elected officials shall be fixed at least 180 days before the beginning of the terms as cited in 50 ILCS 145/2; now,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, shall receive the sum of \$22,500.00 per annum, payable in equal biweekly installments for and during the term of office commencing in May 2013 and thereafter. The Mayor shall not receive insurance benefits provided by the City of DeKalb.

Section 2. That each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this ordinance is

separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval according to law.
