

**AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS CHAPTER 51, "TRAFFIC," SECTION 51.13, "PARKING PROHIBITED," SCHEDULE C, BY PROVIDING FOR NO TRUCK PARKING FOR A PORTION OF LOCUST STREET.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL** of the City of DeKalb, Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois Chapter 51, "Traffic," Section 51.13, "Parking Prohibited," Schedule C, "No Parking Anytime," be amended by deleting the following:

Locust Street, South side, between North Tenth Street and North Eleventh Street. (80-82)

**Section 2.** That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois Chapter 51, "Traffic," Section 51.13, "Parking Prohibited," Schedule C, be amended by inserting in the appropriate place the following:

**51. No Truck Parking, 8:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.**

Locust Street, South side, from North Tenth Street to a point 57 feet from the West right-of-way line of North Eleventh Street.

**Section 3.** That each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

**Section 4.** That except as to the amendments heretofore mentioned, all Sections of the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 5.** Upon its passage and approval according to law, this Ordinance shall, by authority of the City Council be published in pamphlet form. On the tenth day after the date of publication, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect. Publication date: May 15, 2012. Effective date: May 25, 2012.
