

**AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE
CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS, CHAPTER 7,
“WATER SERVICE,” SECTION 7.18, “WATER
RATES.”**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, Chapter 7, “Water Service,” be amended as follows:

7.18 WATER RATES

a) In accordance with the following schedule, the water rate to be charged on all water bills issued on or after November 1 of each year shall be subject to a positive adjustment annually using the increase, if any, in the May over May Consumer Price Index (CPI) – All Urban Consumers for the Chicago, Gary and Kenosha region. This amount shall be derived using the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics information and will be effective July 1 for the November 1 billing. Such rate change shall be implemented by the authority of the Director of Public Works, without need for further approval. (99-86, 07-55, 08-36)

~~July 1, 2008 – \$2.38 per 100 cubic feet~~

~~July 1, 2009 – \$2.62 per 100 cubic feet~~

~~July 1, 2010 – \$2.88 per 100 cubic feet~~

~~July 1, 2011 – \$3.02 per 100 cubic feet~~

~~July 1, 2012 – \$3.17 per 100 cubic feet~~

Section 2. That each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

Section 3. That except as to the amendments heretofore mentioned, all Sections of the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Upon its passage and approval according to law, this Ordinance shall, by authority of the City Council, be published in pamphlet form. On the tenth day after the date of publication, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect. Publication date: June 12, 2012. Effective date: June 22, 2012.
