

RESOLUTION 13-83 PASSED: OCTOBER 14, 2013

RELATING TO TERMINATION OF PARTICIPATION BY THE CITY CLERK IN THE ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb is a participant in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund:

WHEREAS, elected officials with the City of DeKalb may participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund if they are in positions normally requiring performance of duty for 1,000 hours or more per year; and

WHEREAS, this governing body can determine what the normal annual hourly requirements of its elected officials are, and should make such determination for the guidance and direction of the Board of Trustees of the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund; and

WHEREAS, this governing body has previously determined that the following elected position required performance of duty for at least 1,000 hour per year: City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the duties and responsibilities of this position have changed and it no longer requires performance of duty for at least 1,000 hour per year, effective May 6th, 2013.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the DeKalb City Council of the City of DeKalb finds that the position of City Clerk no longer qualifies for IMRF participation, as of May 6th, 2013.
