

AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A SET OF SIX STERIL KONI COLUMN LIFTS WITH APPROPRIATE ACCESSORIES FROM SAFETYLANE AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$101,092.12, UTILIZING GROUND EMERGENCY MEDICAL FUNDING (GEMT FUND 130).

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the "City") is a home rule unit of local government and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the City's corporate authorities find that approving the purchase of six column lifts with appropriate accessories is in the City's best interests for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: The City's corporate authorities approve, authorize, and direct the City Manager to execute an agreement, in a form acceptable to the City Manager, with Safetylane Automotive Equipment, for six (6) sterile Koni column lifts with appropriate accessories, in an amount not to exceed \$101,092.12, in accordance with the Quote attached and incorporated as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2: This resolution and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such resolution should (a) contain terms contrary to the provision of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the City's corporate authorities that to the extent that the terms of this resolution should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, that this resolution shall supersede state law in that regard in its jurisdiction.

SECTION 3: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
