## AUTHORIZING A WORKERS' COMPENSATION LUMP SUM PETITION AND ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22,054.74 (KELLY SULLIVAN).

**WHEREAS,** the City of DeKalb (the "City) is a home rule unit of local government and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

**WHEREAS,** City's attorneys negotiated a lump sum settlement in the total amount of \$22,054.74 for Kelly Sullivan's worker's compensation claim against the City (the "Settlement"); and

**WHEREAS**, the City's corporate authorities find that approving the Settlement is in the City's best interests for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1:** The recitals to this resolution are true, correct, adopted, and incorporated as Section One to this resolution.

**SECTION 2:** The City's corporate authorities approve, authorize, and direct the City Manager or designee to execute a lump sum petition and order for the Settlement of a pending Workers' Compensation Claim with Kelly Sullivan, contemplating the payment of a full and final settlement associated with her injury in the amount of Twenty-Two Thousand Fifty-Four Dollars and Seventy-Four Cents (\$22,054.74), subject to approval by the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission, and to take all necessary actions to effectuate the Settlement.

**SECTION 3:** This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
