AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO ELLIOTT & WOOD, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$183,016 FOR N. NINTH STREET PARKING IMPROVEMENTS, WITH STAFF AUTHORITY TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS UP TO A COMBINED PROJECT TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED \$195,000.

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the City) is a home rule unit of local government and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

**WHEREAS,** on June 30, 2023, the City publicly opened bids for the 9<sup>TH</sup> Street Parking Improvements (the "Project") and determined that Elliot & Wood, Inc. (the "Contractor") submitted the lowest responsible bid in the total amount of \$183,016 (the Bid); and

**WHEREAS**, the City's corporate authorities find that approving the Bid is in the City's best interests for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1:** The recitals to this resolution are true, correct, adopted and incorporated as Section One to this resolution.

**SECTION 2:** The City's corporate authorities approve the Bid and further approve, authorize, and direct the City Manager to enter into an agreement, in a form acceptable to the City Manager, with Contractor for the Project in the Bid amount of \$183,016, with staff authority to approve change orders up to a combined Project total of \$195,000, and to take all necessary actions to effectuate the award of the Bid to Contractor.

**SECTION 3:** This resolution and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such resolution should (a) contain terms contrary to the provision of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the City's corporate authorities that to the extent that the terms of this resolution should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, this resolution shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

**SECTION 4:** This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

No corporation shall be barred from contracting with any unit of State or Local government as a result of a conviction under this Section of any employee or agent of such corporation if the employee so convicted is no longer employed by the corporation and: (1) it has been finally adjudicated not guilty or (2) if it demonstrates to the governmental entity with which it seeks to contract and that entity finds that the commission of the offense was neither authorized, requested, commanded, nor performed by a director, officer or a high managerial agent on behalf of the corporation.





WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the City) is a home rule unit of local government and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2023, the City publicly opened bids for the 2023 Kimberly Drive Segmentation (the "Project") and determined that Elliot & Wood, Inc. (the "Contractor") submitted the lowest responsible bid in the total amount of \$239,500 (the Bid); and

WHEREAS, the City's corporate authorities find that approving the Bid is in the City's best interests for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1:** The recitals to this resolution are true, correct, adopted and incorporated as Section One to this resolution.

**SECTION 2:** The City's corporate authorities approve the Bid and further approve, authorize, and direct the City Manager to enter into an agreement, in a form acceptable to the City Manager, with Contractor for the Project in the Bid amount of \$239,500, with staff authority to approve change orders up to a combined Project total of \$250,000, and to take all necessary actions to effectuate the award of the Bid to Contractor.

**SECTION 3:** This resolution and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such resolution should (a) contain terms contrary to the provision of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the City's corporate authorities that to the extent that the terms of this resolution should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, this resolution shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

**SECTION 4:** This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
