AMENDING CHAPTER 51 "TRAFFIC", SCHEDULE A "ONE WAY TRAFFIC", OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL CODE AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTABLISHING ONE WAY TRAFFIC ON NORMAL ROAD FROM LINCOLN TERRACE TO W. LOCUST STREET.

PASSED: JULY 24, 2023

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the "City") is a home rule unit of local government and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 51 of the City's Municipal Code (the "Code") regulates traffic in the City's corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the City's corporate authorities find that is in the City's best interests to amend Chapter 51 of the Code as provided by this Ordinance to promote the public health, safety, welfare and morals; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: The City's corporate authorities adopt and approve an amendment to Chapter 51, "Traffic", Schedule A "One Way Traffic", of the Code, to state as follows:

Normal Road, between Lincoln Terrace and West Locust Street, Northerly.

SECTION 2: Except as may otherwise be amended by this Ordinance, Chapter 51 of the Code shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such ordinance should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the City's corporate authorities that to the extent that the terms of this Ordinance should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, this Ordinance shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval as provided by law.
