AMENDING RESOLUTION 2023-038 TO INCREASE THE COMBINED PROJECT TOTAL FOR THE ARCHITECTURAL/ENGINEERING, PLANNING AND SPECIAL SERVICES, AND DESIGN PHASE SERVICES FOR PROJECT DKB-4924 FOR THE REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF A PORTION OF THE AIRCRAFT PARKING APRON AT THE DEKALB TAYLOR MUNICIPAL AIRPORT TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$58,827.60 (650-00-00-83900 – CRAWFORD, MURPHY AND TILLY, INC.).

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the "City") is a home rule unit of local government which may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2023, City's corporate authorities adopted Resolution 2023-038, which approved an agreement with Crawford, Murphy and Tilly, Inc. for architectural/engineering, planning and other services regarding the removal and replacement of a portion of the aircraft parking apron at DeKalb Taylor Municipal Airport ("Project DKB-4924") in an amount not to exceed \$47,000; and

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen circumstances, the City's local share of the costs of Project DKB-4924 will exceed \$47,000 in an amount not to exceed a combined project total of \$58,827.60; and

WHEREAS, the City's corporate authorities find that amending the City's local share to an amount not to exceed \$58,827.60 is in the City's best interests for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: The recitals to this resolution are true, material, adopted and incorporated as Section One to this Resolution.

SECTION 2: The City's corporate authorities approve, authorize, and direct the City Manager to perform such acts as may be necessary on the City's behalf to increase the City's local share of the costs of Project DKB-4924 from the prior authorization of \$47,000 to an amount not to exceed a combined project total of \$58,827.60 including, but not limited to, executing an amended agreement with Crawford, Murphy and Tilly, Inc. for architectural/engineering, planning and other services regarding Project DKB-4924 in an amount not to exceed a combined project total of \$58,827.60, executing such forms as may be required by the Illinois Department of Transportation for Project DKB-4924, and appropriating the funds to pay for combined project total not to exceed \$58,827.60.

SECTION 3: This resolution and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such resolution should (a) contain terms contrary to the provision of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the corporate authorities of the City of DeKalb that to the extent that the terms of this resolution should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, that this resolution shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

SECTION 4: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR ARCHITECTURAL/ENGINEERING, PLANNING AND SPECIAL SERVICES, AND DESIGN PHASE SERVICES WITH CRAWFORD, MURPHY AND TILLY, INC. FOR PROJECT DKB-4924 FOR THE REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF A PORTION OF THE AIRCRAFT PARKING APRON AT THE DEKALB TAYLOR MUNICIPAL AIRPORT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$47,000 (650-00-00-83900).

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the "City) is a home rule unit of local government and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII. Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the City's corporate authorities previously approved Project DKB-4924 to replace a portion of the aircraft parking apron at the DeKalb Taylor Municipal Airport for a total estimated cost of \$940,000 with the City's share not to exceed \$55,000 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project requires the approval of a standard agreement for architectural/engineering, planning and special services; and

WHEREAS, the City's Airport Manager recommends approving an agreement for architectural/engineering planning and special services for the Project with Crawford, Murphy, and Tilly, Inc. in the form attached and incorporated as Exhibit A (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City's corporate authorities find that approving the Agreement is in the City's best interests for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare; and
