

**SCHEDULE F
“LIMITED PARKING – CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT”**

In accordance with Section 51.14, no person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time indicated on the following streets:

Fifteen Minutes:

Pond Municipal Lot – the two northernmost non-handicapped stalls on the west side of the parking lot located south of E. Lincoln Highway, north of Girard Street, west of S. Seventh Street.

Three Hours, Between 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.:

Embree Municipal Lot – Seventy-five (75) stalls of the parking lot located south of E. Lincoln Highway, just north of the railroad tracks between S. First Street and S. Second Street.

Frank Van Buer Plaza – Fifty-one (51) stalls of the parking lot located on the south side of E. Locust Street, on the east side of N. Second Street.

Pond Municipal Lot – Five (5) stalls on the east side, and the southernmost two (2) stalls and the northernmost stall on the west side of the parking lot located on the south side of E. Lincoln Highway, north of Girard Street, and just west of S. Seventh Street.

Unlimited Parking:

Municipal Building Parking Lot – All stalls in the Municipal Building parking lot located at 200 S. Fourth Street shall be unlimited parking except as may be otherwise posted. (1984-030)

Reserved Parking Only, Tow Zone (any handicapped spaces are excluded):

Ellwood Municipal Lot – The fifteen (15) parking stalls on the south side of the center island in the parking lot located on the east side of N. Second Street, just north of E. Locust Street.

Glidden Municipal Lot – The southernmost thirteen (13) parking stalls of the parking lot located on the west side of N. Second Street just south of Oak Street.

Gurler Municipal Lot – The northernmost seventeen (17) parking stalls of the parking lot located on the north side of Grove Street, between S. Third Street and S. Fourth Street.

Haish Municipal Lot – The southernmost thirteen (13) parking stalls of the parking lot located on the east side of N. Third Street, just north of E. Locust Street.

Huntley Municipal Lot – Some undesignated permitted stalls of the parking lot located on the north side of Grove Street just east of S. Fifth Street.

Vaughn Municipal Lot – The center twenty-eight (28) parking stalls on the east side of the parking lot located between S. First Street and S. Second Street just south of the railroad tracks.

Unrestricted Daytime Parking:

Ellwood Municipal Lot – Sixty (60) stalls in the parking lot located on the east side of N. Second Street, just north of E. Locust Street, excluding fifteen (15) parking stalls on the south side of the center island.

Ferguson Municipal Lot – Twenty-four (24) stalls of the parking lot located on the north side of Grove Street just west of S. Seventh Street.

Frost Municipal Lot – Twenty-five (25) stalls of the parking lot located on the south side of E. Locust Street, between N. Sixth Street and N. Seventh Street.

Glidden Municipal Lot – Forty-four (44) stalls of the parking lot located on the west side of N. Second Street just south of Oak Street, excluding the southernmost 13 parking stalls.

Gurler Municipal Lot – One hundred thirty-nine (139) stalls of the parking lot located on the north side of Grove Street, between S. Third Street and S. Fourth Street, excluding the northernmost 17 parking stalls.

Haish Municipal Lot – Fifty-eight (58) stalls of the parking lot located on the east side of N. Third Street, just north of E. Locust Street, excluding the southernmost 13 parking stalls.

Huntley Municipal Lot – Thirty-eight (38) stalls of the parking lot located on the north side of Grove Street just east of S. Fifth Street, with some undesignated permitted stalls.

King Municipal Lot – Twenty-six (26) stalls of the parking lot located on the east side of N. Fourth Street, north of E. Lincoln Highway.

Vaughn Municipal Lot – Seventy-eight (78) stalls of the parking lot located between S. First Street and S. Second Street just south of the railroad tracks, excluding the center 28 parking stalls on the east side of the lot.
