AWARDING A BID TO PERFORMANCE CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$585,564 FOR 1,400 FEET OF WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT ON N. FIRST STREET BETWEEN THE BRIDGE AND TILTON PARK DRIVE AND IN MARKET SQUARE SHOPPING CENTER WITH STAFF AUTHORITY TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS UP TO \$644,000.

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the "City") is a home rule unit of local government and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, on January 29, 2025, City staff publicly opened sealed bids for the replacement of approximately 1,400 feet of watermain on North First Street between the Bridge and Tilton Park Drive and identified the lowest responsible bidder as Performance Construction Engineering ("PCE") with a bid in the amount of \$585,564 per the attached and incorporated as Exhibit A (the "Bid"); and

WHEREAS, the City's corporate authorities find that approving the Bid is in the City's best interests for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1:** The recitals to this resolution are true, correct, adopted and incorporated as Section One to this resolution.

**SECTION 2:** The City's corporate authorities approve the Bid and further authorize and direct the City Manager to: (1) negotiate and enter into an agreement with PEC for the Bid in the amount of \$585,564 with City staff authority to approve change orders for a project total not to exceed \$644,000; and (2) perform such acts as may be necessary to effectuate the award of the Bid.

**SECTION 3:** This resolution and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such resolution should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the City's corporate authorities that to the extent this resolution is inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, this resolution shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

**SECTION 4:** This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

No corporation shall be barred from contracting with any unit of State or Local government as a result of a conviction under this Section of any employee or agent of such corporation if the employee so convicted is no longer employed by the corporation and: (1) it has been finally adjudicated not guilty or (2) if it demonstrates to the governmental entity with which it seeks to contract and that entity finds that the commission of the offense was neither authorized, requested, commanded, nor performed by a director, officer or a high managerial agent on behalf of the corporation.

- 3. Bribery. The bidder or contractor or subcontractor, respectively, certifies that, it has not been convicted of bribery or attempting to bribe an officer or employee of the State of Illinois or any unit of local government, nor has the firm made an admission of guilt of such conduct which is a matter or record, nor has an official, agent, or employee of the firm committed bribery or attempted bribery on behalf of the firm and pursuant to the direction or authorization of a responsible official of the firm.
- 4. Interim Suspension or Suspension.
