

AUTHORIZING PAYMENTS TO MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY SERVICES (MES) FOR THREE SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS (SCBA) UNITS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$26,100 USING GROUND EMERGENCY MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION (GEMT) FUNDING (FUND 130).

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb (the "City") is a home rule unit of local government and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs under Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the City's Fire Chief recommends the purchase of three (3) self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) from Municipal Emergency Services in an amount not to exceed \$26,100.00 per the quote attached and incorporated as Exhibit A (the "Quote"); and

WHEREAS, the City's corporate authorities find that approving the Quote is in the City's best interests for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: The recitals to this resolution are true, material, adopted and incorporated as Section One to this resolution.

SECTION 2: The City's corporate authorities waive all applicable competitive bid requirements and approve the Quote. The City's corporate authorities further authorize and direct the City Manager to: (1) negotiate and execute an agreement with Municipal Emergency Services for the purchase of three (3) SCBA in an amount not to exceed \$26,100.00 per the Quote; and (2) take all necessary acts to effectuate the Quote.

SECTION 3: This resolution shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such resolution should (a) contain terms contrary to the provision of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the City's corporate authorities that to the extent that the terms of this resolution should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, that this resolution shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.


SECTION 4: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
