

**ORDINANCE 11-02 Passed on January 24, 2011**

**AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE  
CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS CHAPTER 3,  
“CITY ADMINISTRATION,” SECTION 3.46,  
“RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR  
EMPLOYEES AND OFFICERS.”**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL** of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, Chapter 3, “City Administration”, Section 3.46, “Residency Requirements for Employees and Officers,” is revised as follows:

- f) Employees in the position of ~~department head~~ ***police chief and fire chief hired after 2-1-11*** shall be required to establish residency within the corporate limits of the City within fifteen (15) months of the date of hire, with the City Manager authorized to grant extensions for a period not to exceed an additional six (6) months.

**Section 2.** That each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

**Section 3.** That except as to the amendments heretofore mentioned, all Sections of the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 4.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval according to law.
