

AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS, CHAPTER 9, "ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES," SECTION 9.04, "AMBULANCE SERVICE FEES."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, Chapter 9, "Establishment of Fees," Section 9.04, "Ambulance Service Fees," be amended as shown following:

9.04 AMBULANCE SERVICE FEES. (08-16)

a) Fees for ambulance service provided by the City of DeKalb shall be as follows:

Transport/Loaded Mile	\$ 9.28 /mile	
Basic Life Support (resident)	\$ 423.00	\$ 433.00
Basic Life Support (resident in Northern Illinois University – owned housing)	\$ 520.00	\$ 530.00
Basic Life Support (non-resident)	\$ 612.00	\$ 622.00
Advanced Life Support 1 (resident)	\$ 504.00	\$ 514.00
Advanced Life Support 1 (resident in Northern Illinois University – owned housing)	\$ 619.00	\$ 629.00
Advanced Life Support 1 (non-resident)	\$ 729.00	\$ 739.00
Advanced Life Support 2 (resident)	\$ 729.00	\$ 739.00
Advanced Life Support 2 (resident in Northern Illinois University – owned housing)	\$ 889.00	\$ 899.00
Advanced Life Support 2 (non-resident)	\$1,052.00	\$1,062.00
Intercept – Residents	\$ 463.00	\$ 473.00
Intercept – Non-Resident	\$ 670.00	\$ 680.00

b) On or before July 1 of each year, the *Transport/Loaded Mile*, Basic and Advanced Life Support fees for residents, residents in Northern Illinois University – owned housing and non-residents shall be adjusted in accordance with the ~~current~~ **most recent** Consumer Price Index (*CPI*) - *All Urban Consumers*

~~Adjustment Rate~~ for the Chicago, Gary and Lake County *Kenosha* region. *The adjusted fees shall be rounded up to the nearest whole dollar except for the Transport/Loaded Mile fee which shall be rounded up to the nearest cent.* (06-78)

Section 2. That each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

Section 3. That except as to the amendments heretofore mentioned, all Sections of the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Upon its passage and approval according to law, this Ordinance shall, by authority of the City Council, be published in pamphlet form. On the tenth day after the date of publication, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect. Publication date: July 26, 2011. Effective date: August 5, 2011.
