

AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS, CHAPTER 51, "TRAFFIC," SECTION 51.17, "MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS AND PARKING STALLS," BY NAMING MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS AFTER HISTORICAL FIGURES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, Chapter 51, "Traffic", Section 51.17, "Municipal Parking Lots and Parking Stalls", be amended by inserting a new language in Subsection (a), as shown following:

51.17 MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS AND PARKING STALLS. (81-69)

a) Definitions. Terms used in this Section have the following meanings:

Street: Every way set apart for public travel except alley- ways, bridle paths and foot paths.

Roadway: That portion of a street between the regularly established curb lines.

Sidewalk: That portion of a street between the curb lines and adjacent property lines.

Parking Zones: Portions of streets or parking lots described and established by Council as zones within which the parking of vehicles shall be controlled, regulated, and inspected. The areas set forth in Schedule E and Schedule F, attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby established as parking zones. (03-112)

Parking Space/Stall: An unenclosed area or portion of a designated parking zone specifically marked and sufficient in size to park thereon one vehicle.

Municipal Parking Lots: Areas owned or leased by the City of DeKalb and identified by number and name for the purpose of the parking of vehicles as follows:

Section 2. That each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

Section 3. That except as to the amendments heretofore mentioned, all Sections of the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Upon its passage and approval according to law, this Ordinance shall, by authority of the City Council be published in pamphlet form. On and after the tenth day after the date of publication, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect. Publication date: August 9, 2011 Effective date: August 19, 2011.
