

AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF
THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS,
CHAPTER 38, "INTOXICATING LIQUORS,"
SECTION 38.12-1 "POWERS OF THE
LIQUOR COMMISSIONER."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois, Chapter 38, "Intoxicating Liquors", Section 38.03, "Powers of the Liquor Commissioner," be amended as follows:

38.12-1 POWERS OF THE LIQUOR COMMISSIONER

The Liquor Commissioner shall have the following powers, functions and duties:

b) To receive *or direct* complaints from any citizen of the City that any of the provisions of this Chapter have been or are being violated *to the appropriate City staff for investigation and/or prosecution* and to act upon such complaints in a manner hereinafter provided.

Section 2. That each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

Section 3. That except as to the amendments heretofore mentioned, all Sections of the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 4. Upon its passage and approval according to law, this Ordinance shall, by authority of the City Council be published in pamphlet form. On the tenth day after the date of publication, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect. Publication date: August 9, 2011. Effective date: August 19, 2011.
