

AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS, CHAPTER 51 "TRAFFIC", SCHEDULE C "PARKING PROHIBITED" REGARDING GARDEN DRIVE PARKING RESTRICTIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb, DeKalb County, Illinois is a home rule community with those powers granted under the provisions of the Illinois Constitution and the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, *et. seq.*; and,

WHEREAS, the City of DeKalb has the authority pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code and its home rule powers to impose parking restrictions within the City of DeKalb; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the alteration of parking restrictions as contemplated below is required to properly promote the public health, safety, welfare and morals; and,

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of DeKalb, DeKalb County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance Amended.

Subsection (3) of Schedule C of Chapter 51 of the City Code of Ordinances is hereby amended with the following addition:

- (3) No Parking 2:00am to 6:00am.

The east side of Garden Drive between Lucinda Drive and West Hillcrest Drive.

Subsection (1) of Schedule C shall be amended to remove the reference to parking restrictions on the east side of Garden drive between Lucinda Drive and West Hillcrest Drive.


Section 2. All ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.


Section 3. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions will remain in full force and affect the same as if the invalid provision had not been a part of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage and publication pursuant to law. Publication date: December 9, 2014. Effective date: December 19, 2014.
