2018 Street Maintenance Program Begins July 11, 2018

On July 11, 2018, Curran Contracting Company (Curran) will begin the 2018 Street Maintenance Program. This year's program will focus on three geographic areas throughout the City and conclude with a citywide crack-filling schedule. The tables below list the streets that comprise each scheduled work area. For each area, crews will work in three phases to replace damaged curbs, sidewalks, driveway approaches, and repave streets.

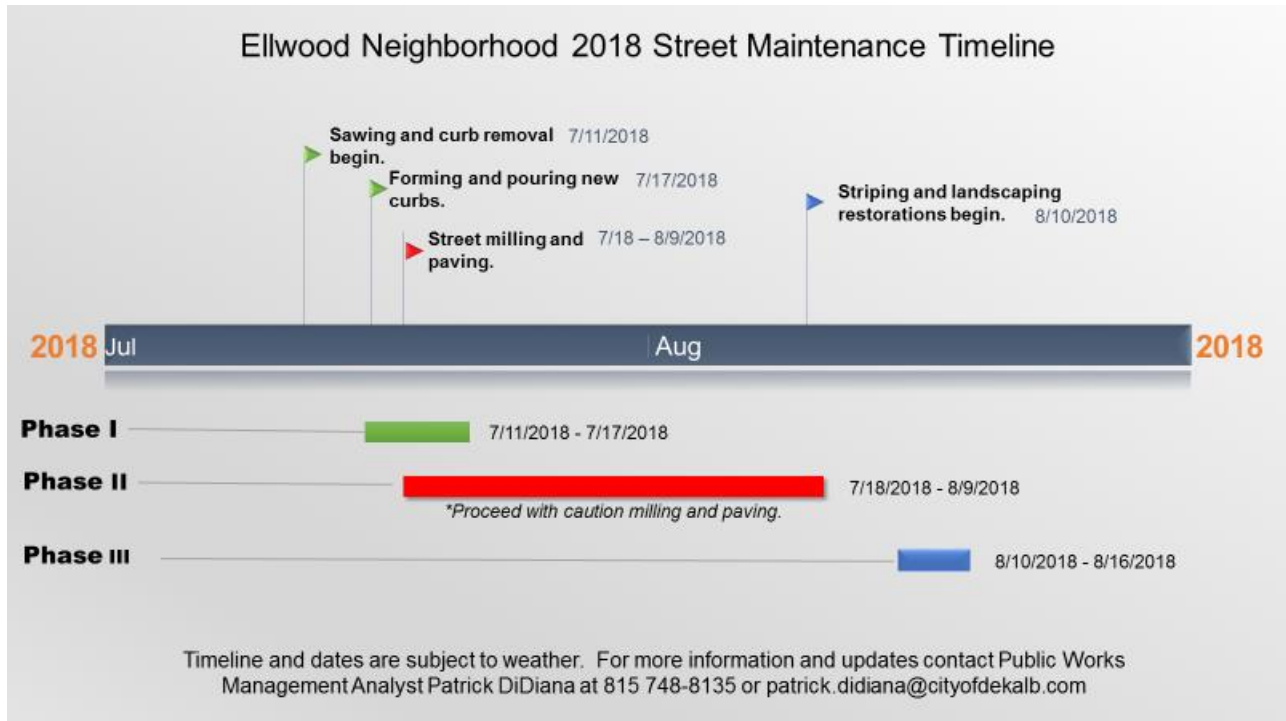

The timeline on the next page describes each phase of work for the Ellwood Neighborhood. Timeline dates for the Ellwood Neighborhood are subject to change due to weather. Curran has targeted August 16, 2018 as the end date for all work in the Ellwood Neighborhood. As the program progresses, the City will provide residents

located on Ridge Drive, East Taylor Street, Maplewood Avenue, and S. 11th Street with timelines specific to their geographic area.



With the Phase II of the Safe Streets Initiative fully implemented, residents of the Ellwood Neighborhood will experience added traffic/parking restrictions during construction. However, Public Works will work with both the contractor and Police Department to communicate updates, minimize extended parking restrictions, and provide grace periods for residents experiencing extended parking restrictions.
