2019 WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT CITY OF DEKALB

Construction of water main replacement along Joanne Lane, Golfview Place and Ilehamwood Drive in the City of DeKalb were financed by the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The SFR is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA). This project includes replacement of a 60-year-old cast iron water main that was prone to breakage, with a new 8" ductile iron water main including installation of new copper water service lines. Once complete, it will improve water quality for area residents and businesses in DeKalb by improving reliability of water service delivery and increased pressure/fire flows. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
